Acknowledging Arbor Day. Promoting and Encouraging All Residents to Protect Trees and Woodlands

Cuyahoga County, Ohio

Be It Resolved by the Township Trustees of Olmsted Township that

Whereas, in 1872, the Nebraska Board of Agriculture established a special day to be set aside for the planting of trees, and

Whereas, this holiday, called Arbor Day, was first observed with the planting of more than a million trees in Nebraska, and

Whereas, Arbor Day is now observed throughout the nation and the world, and

Whereas, trees can be a solution to combating climate change by reducing the erosion of our precious topsoil by wind and water, cutting heating and cooling costs, moderating the temperature, cleaning the air, and

Whereas, trees in our township increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of business areas, and beautify our community, and

Whereas, trees — wherever they are planted — are a source of joy and spiritual renewal.

Therefore Be It Proclaimed, the Olmsted Township Board of Trustees, do hereby proclaim as April 27, 2024 as ARBOR DAY and we urge all citizens to celebrate Arbor Day and to support efforts to protect our trees and woodlands, and

Further, we urge all citizens to plant trees to gladden the heart and promote the well-being of this and future generations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Township Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
