

## RESOLUTION 126-2022

*Authorizing Tree Removal/Sidewalk Replacement Program Breezewood Neighborhood*

Cuyahoga County, Ohio

*Be it Resolved by the Township Trustees of Olmsted Township, that*

*Whereas*, one of the highest priorities of residents in Olmsted Township is connectivity and walkability as expressed in the 2013 NOACA TLCI (Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative), the Master Plan for Land Use 2013 and the Comprehensive Plan 2019, all foundational documents that provided input from residents and the business community, and

*Whereas*, the Olmsted Township Board of Trustees has continued to affirm the above noted documents as they advocate for complete streets and the placement of sidewalks in road repair, replacement, and resurfacing projects, and

*Whereas*, COVID has increased the need for connectivity and walkability as more people work from home, young people look for opportunities to interact with school friends, and older residents choose to remain active, and

*Whereas*, very mature trees in our oldest subdivision, the Breezewood neighborhood are creating a hazardous situation on adjacent sidewalk as roots invade and cause uneven pavement, and



*Whereas*, the Board of Trustees has determined the need for a program to remove trees in the most compromised areas, grind the stump, replace sidewalk adjacent to the tree, and replant a more suitable alternative in this Breezewood neighborhood, now

*Therefore be it resolved*, the Olmsted Township Board of Trustees authorize the Tree Removal/Sidewalk Replacement Program in the Breezewood neighborhood using ARPA (American Rescue Plan) funding to provide a safe walkable neighborhood for residents on this 26<sup>th</sup> day of October 2022, and

*Be it further resolved* that it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
