

RESOLUTION 121-2022

Cook Road Sidewalk Project – North Side of Cook Road from the corner of MacKenzie Road (western terminus) to 26956 Cook Road (eastern terminus)

Whereas, Olmsted Township has worked with NOACA (Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency) since 2013 to develop a comprehensive TLCI (Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative) program for sidewalk development, and

Whereas, the NOACA TLCI Plan, the Master Plan 2013 and the updated Strategic Plan 2019 present a blueprint for Olmsted Township that consistently voices the request of residents for robust sidewalk development and connectivity throughout the Community, and

Whereas, the northern section of Olmsted Township is unique as it allows accessibility to Villages of Lakeside residents on the south side of Cook Road, residents of the Hunters Ridge neighborhood and residents living on Township main roads; more than 535 homes/over 1000 residents will be served. This section of the Township includes a diverse population with young families, seniors and “boomers” who value living in Olmsted Township, and

Whereas, the proposed sidewalk will provide a vital link to goods and services, a park, other neighborhoods, the Academic and Town Center Economic Corridors, government buildings, healthy outdoor opportunities, now within safe walking/biking distance of their homes, and

Whereas, NOACA TLCI is accepting submissions for sidewalk implementation projects (under \$300,000 in cost) up to 80% of the total project cost with a 20% match from the local community, now

Therefore be it resolved the Olmsted Township Board of Trustees approve the submission of the proposal for the Cook Road Sidewalk Project with a request for \$169,900 on this date 12 October 2022, and

Be it further resolved that it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
