

## RESOLUTION 126-2021

To apply for Township Stimulus Funding  
Avondale Court Cul-de-Sac Project

Cuyahoga County, Ohio

Be It Resolved by the Township Trustees of Olmsted Township that

**Whereas**, the Township Stimulus Program is a one-time program that provides Federal funds to townships for sidewalks, roadways and culvert projects located within township limits. The allocation for this program will be administered by ODOT's Division of Planning, Office of Local Programs. The total funding available to this program is \$8 million and a funding limit of \$250,000 per project has been established. ODOT will provide 100% of eligible costs for all phases of the project, up to the specified project funding limit. There are 1308 townships in the State of Ohio. Monies received must be spent by December 31, 2024, and

**Whereas**, Olmsted Township Board of Trustees continue to look for opportunities to take advantage of grants available to augment and supplement property tax revenue, now

**Now, Therefore, be it resolved** that the Board of Trustees is seeking funding for the Avondale Court Cul-de-Sac Project. Engineering, bidding and contract award for the project will take place Winter 2022 with construction Summer 2022. Total cost of the project is \$370,000. Olmsted Township is requesting \$250,000 towards the project. The remaining \$120,000 will be taken from Olmsted Township General Fund.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Township Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
