

RESOLUTION 107-2021

Zoning Commission and Board of Zoning Appeals Stipend

Be It Resolved by the Township Trustees of
Olmsted Township that

Whereas, citizen resident members of the Zoning Commission and the Board of Zoning Appeals serve an important function in township government as they represent the voice of the people regarding zoning and development and as the decision making body regarding appeals by residents, and

Whereas, many townships in Ohio demonstrate their appreciation to the members of the Zoning Commission and Board of Zoning Appeals by paying a stipend to members for attendance at meetings, and

Whereas, the Olmsted Township Board of Trustees has determined this practice has merit as a tangible reminder of the service provided by the resident members of these two bodies, now

Therefore, be it resolved, the Olmsted Township Board of Trustees will remit a \$25 stipend per meeting to members of the Zoning Commission and Board of Zoning Appeals who are sitting as a voting member of the Zoning Commission and/or Board of Zoning Appeals on a given evening; the stipend will begin with meetings conducted in October 2021, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Township Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
